Call to Order: Meeting was called to order 3:02 by Chair Person Laura Shannon
Roll Call: Sign In Sheet was sent around by Mr. Scribner for all members to sign in.
Based on parody and needing parent vs. teachers to be equal Amy Niess and Itait Esquivel were removed from council but were invited to attend meetings with the understanding that they are not able to vote on any matters. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes: Sarah Morse made a motion to approve minutes as they were written and Christine Booth 2nd; all members present were in favor of approving September minutes as written.

Old Business:

1. Clarification of members and roles: Mr. Scribner clarified that there must be an equal number of parents vs teachers and due to that 2 staff members were removed as voting members, council is now back to 10 members.

New Business:

1. Review SPSA Goal #1 which is to increase overall student growth in English Language Arts. Mr. Scribner stated that they will begin offering tutoring in Math/ELA/DI in 6wk increments to help improve student performance. The testing that would be used to see growth would be i-ready
2. Review Performance Data:
 - a. After reviewing data Sarah Morse asked if there were different testing techniques to measure growth instead of i-ready. Jill Blevins pointed out that it doesn't measure growth properly because some students are most concerned about completing their minutes and that there are discrepancies when using this system.

 - a. Mr. Scribner reviewed LCAP goals with the council and informed us that things will change next year based on new LCAP guidelines.
